## BYLAW VIII. FEES AND DUES

## **SECTION 1.**

The annual dues for active members currently employed by a police department, or division of the Iowa Department of Public Safety designated in Bylaw I, section 2 (b), or peace officers designated in Bylaw I, section 2 (e) shall be forty *fifty* dollars *(\$50)*. The annual dues for active members who have been pensioned, vested, and/or retired from a police department, or division of the Iowa Department of Public Safety designated in Bylaw I, section 2 (b), or peace officers designated in Bylaw I, section 2 (b), or peace officers designated in Bylaw I, section 2 (b), or peace officers designated in Bylaw I, section 2 (e) shall be thirty *thirty-five* dollars *(\$35)*. All dues shall be payable on January 1, of each year.

An active member who has been pensioned, vested, and/or retired from a police department, or division of the Iowa Department of Public Safety designated in Bylaw I, section 2 (b), or peace officers designated in Bylaw I, section 2 (e), and has reached the age of fifty-five (55) may apply to the Secretary-Treasurer for a one-time paid up active membership at a cost of two-hundred *two hundred fifty* dollars *(\$250)*, due within sixty days (60) after approval by the Board of Directors. A paid up active membership is not considered a life membership as outlined in Bylaw I, section 4.

The annual dues for active membership shall be set by two-thirds majority vote of the delegates at the annual conference.

Persons admitted to active membership after the beginning of a calendar year shall pay dues for that entire year.

Members of local units shall pay their dues to this association through the Secretary of their local units. Under no circumstances shall any portion of the stated dues be refundable.
